COVID-19 PATIENT SCREENING

If you are experiencing any symptoms related to COVID-19, we ask that you do not come to our office at this time. Symptoms are indicated below:

Cough, shortness of breath, or difficulty breathing

Or any two of the following:

Fever

Chills

Repeated shaking with chills

Muscle pain

Headache

Sore throat

New loss of taste or smell

This list is not all inclusive.

Please consult your medical provider if you have any other severe symptoms that concern you.

If you develop any of the following symptoms (warning signs) for COVID-19, seek emergency medical attention immediately:

Trouble breathing

Persistent pain or pressure in the chest

New confusion or inability to arouse

Bluish lips or face

PATIENT QUESTIONNAIRE

- 1. Have you traveled anywhere recently that are locations of high disease outbreak in last 14 days?
- 2. Have you been in contact with anyone who was sick or was a confirmed SARS-COV-2 virus (novel coronavirus) patient in the last 14 days?
- 3. Have you attended any large group functions in the last 14 days?

- 4. Have you had any of the following symptoms within the last two weeks: fever, fatigue, dry cough, altered taste, altered smell, trouble breathing, productive cough (mucous in cough), or muscle pain?
- 5. Have you previously had the SARS-COV-2 virus (novel coronavirus)? If so, did you test positive and when was the last time you had any symptoms? How do you know you are now free of the virus?
- 6. Are you over the age of 65 and/or have preexisting health conditions related to the following: diabetes, chronic lung disease or asthma, serious heart condition, immunocompromised, or chronic kidney or liver disease?
